

**Vision 2020 Infrastructure Meeting Notes
March 17, 2009**

The Infrastructure Committee of Vision 2020 met on March 17, 2009, at 8:00 a.m. in the Lufkin/Angelina Chamber of Commerce Community Room. Present were James Freeman (City of Hudson), Dennis McDuffie (City of Diboll), Bruce Milstead (City of Huntington), and Susie Cardwell with Bob Brown presiding.

Bob Brown opened the meeting at 8:07 a.m. with an introduction of attendees and a welcome to all.

Green Infrastructure (*Susie Cardwell in the absence of Ellen Temple*)
Green Infrastructure Plan (brochures) were handed out to all present and discussed. James Freeman requested more information on the green infrastructure plan for Hudson with the prospect of Hudson building a new park.

City of Diboll (*Dennis McDuffie*):

Diboll Water – The City Counsel will have a workshop on Thursday regarding the \$9.2 million project. They will probably buy water from the city of Lufkin. They need approximately 200 million gallons per year.

City of Hudson (*James Feeman*)

Storm Recovery - The City of Hudson is still recovering from the storm.

Growth - The City remains a bedroom community with most retail and commercial growth being in Lufkin. Sales tax is steadily increasing.

City of Huntington (*Bruce Milstead*)

Schools - Bruce reported that the multi-million dollar schools are on-line.

Street Work - There are plans for street improvement. They will try to do as much of the street work internally as possible.
